Show Jumping & Style Jumping Qualifier

Class 1A: Junior 70cm
Class 1B: Junior 70cm Team
Class 2A: Senior 70cm
Class 2B: Senior 70cm Team

0 BE Foundation Points. 0 BS Club Points (gained at 90cm or higher) other than notional points gained in 70cm and 80 cm classes held at BS Intro shows. BS Club points gained at any level will not be counted except for 70cm SJ. Riders who have competed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years are not permitted. Horses may not have completed a BE or BRC 100 or above in the current or previous calendar year.

Class 3A: Junior 80cm
Class 3B: Junior 80cm Team
Class 4A: Senior 80cm
Class 4B: Senior 80cm Team

5 BE point. 75 BS Points other than notional points gained in 70cm and 80 cm classes held at BS Intro shows. BS Club points gained at any level will not be counted except for 70cm SJ. Riders who have competed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years are not permitted. Horses may be currently registered with BE but must not have or completed BE 105 or above in the current or previous calendar year.

Class 5A: Junior 90cm
Class 5B: Junior 90cm Team
Class 6A: Senior 90cm
Class 6B: Senior 90cm Team

20 BE Points. 500 BS Points other than notional points gained in 70cm and 80 cm classes held at BS Intro shows. BS Club points gained at any level will not be counted except for 70cm SJ. Riders who have competed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years are not permitted.

Class 7A: Junior/Senior 1m
Class 7B: Mixed 1m Team

Mixed class open to senior and junior teams and individuals, teams may be any combination of senior and/or junior. 60 BE Points. 999 BS Points other than notional points gained in 70cm and 80 cm classes held at BS Intro shows. BS Club points gained at any level will not be counted except for 70cm SJ. Riders who have competed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years are not permitted.

Class 8A: Junior/Senior 105cm
Class 8B: Mixed 105cm Team

This is a mixed class open to senior and junior teams and individuals, teams may be any combination of senior and/or junior.
No limit BE/BS Points.

Class 9: Junior Style Jumping
Class 10: Senior Style Jumping
Class 11: Team Style Jumping

75cm: 0 BE Points. 0 BS Points other than notional points gained in 70cm and 80 cm classes held at BS Intro shows. BS Club points gained at any level will not be counted except for 70cm SJ. Riders who have competed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years. , FBHS, BHSI and BHSII (Qualification not to have been gained within the past ten years (formerly BHSI and above)) are not permitted. Riders who have competed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years are not permitted. Horses may be registered with BE but must not have any BE points. Not to have completed a BE 100 or above in the current or previous calendar year

85cm: 10 BE Points.

Qualifier Format

Option 1 - 1 round following straight onto a jump-off, with all competitors going forward to the jump-off section.

Competing at more than one height: A horse may compete at consecutive heights in show jumping. Style Jumping is classed as a separate competition.

No horse may compete twice in the same team or in more than one team in the same competition unless expressly permitted. Juniors and seniors may share horses/ponies provided they are competing in accordance to these rules. Style Jumping – horse may only compete at one height.

PLEASE ENSURE ALL BRC COMPETITORS GET A COPY OF THE SCHEDULE AND ARE FULLY AWARE OF THE SPECIFIC RULES THAT APPLY TO THE AREA QUALIFIER

Prelim Entries: All entrants must pay a prelim entry of £40 per team or £12 per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (Sunday 4th June) Prelim entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries (www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-downloads), or online entries can be made via the prelim website <https://brc.bhs.org.uk/login?referral=%2Fselect>

BRC Area Qualifier Rules & Competitor Information

BRC Area Qualifiers will be run under BRC Official Rules 2023 which can be found online at <https://www.bhs.org.uk/media/1z3n0vwi/brc-handbook-2023-final.pdf>

Withdrawals/Team Changes:

Must be made by email to the On the Day Secretary before Thursday 22nd June except in exceptional circumstances. Changes after 1700 hrs on Thursday 22nd June must be made at the competition before the appropriate class starts.

Equine Influenza Certificate:

All BRC competitors must have an up-to-date Equine Influenza Certificate which must, under penalty of elimination, accompany the horse to a qualifying competition. The competitor is responsible for producing the Certificate when collecting their number.

A photocopy of any horses not on the database must be sent to the Entries Secretary with the Official Entry Form. Photocopies need not be sent for any horse confirmed as listed on the Area 10 Database 2023.

Horse-box Sign:

Please clearly display on an A4 sign inside the windscreen of your vehicle your Club, your own name and contact number (plus emergency contact number for the day). This will facilitate us contacting you in an emergency.

Hat Tagging:

All hats must be tagged before competitors may ride. Hats may be tagged at the competition in the Secretary's Area. See BRC Rules Appendix 4. All hats must be tagged with a PINK Coloured Tag – BRC, BE or PC.
