VACCINATIONS for HORSES IN AREA COMPETITIONS – NEW RULES FROM MARCH 2020

From 1 March 2020 it will be mandatory when competing at BRC area events and championships to have a flu vaccination within 6 months and 21 days of the competition.

IMPORTANT:

This does not mean vaccinations have to be done every 6 months you can continue with annual boosters **BUT** in order to compete at an area event or championship **the most recent booster injection must have been given within the six calendar months and 21 days prior to the horse arriving at the competition**

- For example, if your competition was the 22 September, you would need to have a vaccination after March 1st (1 March - 1 September = 6 months + 21 days = 22 September).
- This rule applies to Area Qualifiers and Championships only.

Extra bit added at the bottom of the checker where you can enter competition date and check your last vaccine was within the allotted days or not.

2020 Microchips Rule Change – October 2020

Microchips From 1st October 2018, all horses in England (not just those born since 2009) will have to be micro-chipped by law.

There was a 2 year grace period, to give time to organise getting older horses' micro-chipped so from 1st October 2020, it will be an enforceable law.

After this date all horses attending a BRC qualifier or championship (regardless of where they reside) must be micro-chipped. If not they will be disqualified.

You will need to provide your horse's Micro-chip number on the entry form

BEING IN A TEAM

WHAT3WORDS.COM

You may well have heard of the what3words app. Liz Roberts had first hand experience of how this app can help in an emergency. A horse box she was travelling in on the M25 had a blow out and they needed rescuing horses & all. By phoning the emergency services and using the app to give her three word address they could pinpoint her position exactly and this speeded up the whole process. With this every 3m square of the world has its own unique three word address and so if you had a fall out hacking and needed rescuing you could give the emergency services or whoever you call for help the three words and they could pinpoint where you are exactly. Vicki Wise, LANTRA Accredited Horse Fit Bit Consultant and FDRC Member, will discuss the importance of bit and bridle fit to improve a horse's comfort, biomechanics and their welfare.

Horse Fit Bit believe that the correct fit of both a bit and bridle are equally as important as saddle fit and should not be left to trial and error. Vicki has been qualified and working as a freelance Horse Bit Fit Consultant for over a year now and has already performed consultations for over 170 horses across the South East.

Vicki will give a talk with slides and then we will move outside for a practical demonstration.

During the talk, Vicki will cover:

- Bit and bridle fit to improve horse's comfort and biomechanics.
- Dispelling some traditional myths surrounding biting.
- Looking at some of the latest research on biting and bridle fit.
- Understanding anatomy in relation to bit and bridle fit.
- Looking at behavioural and physical issues arising from poor biting and bridle fit to improve horse's welfare.

FDRC AGM held on 10th Feb at Norton Village Hall

The AGM was very well attended this year with 25 Members plus the Committee at Norton Village Hall on a very wet & windy night. Our chair Anne Ball could not be with us but the meeting was ably chaired by our vice-chair Liz Roberts who gave a report of the Clubs activities for the past year and things to look forward to in 2020.

Liz reported that our membership dropped bit in 2019 , this has a knock on effect to club finances, less members to pick teams from, less members to attend clinics, less members to help or attend shows which we organise – these shows are our main fund raisers. We pay BRC in arrears for our affiliation fees, so a good membership year followed by a poor membership year really impacts our finances.

In 2019 we ran and organised 30 different events, which included: Area 10 Combined Training Competition at Felbridge, Training in polework, jumping and TREC plus Horse Agility, BBQ & Quiz night, Talks & Demos, a General Show, Versatile Trec Horse, two dog shows and ended the year with the Xmas Pudding Dog Walk – so quite a varied programme.

Liz went on to say that we sent teams, individual riders & helpers to 11 Area & Friendly competitions with a good rate of success and enjoyment on the part of the riders and all those involved. Many thanks to all those

who represented the club and who gave up their free time to be helpers. We also had the following riders qualify for varying championships - Horse Trials (Faye Smith), Dressage to Music Julia Izzard, Debbie Harris, Liz Roberts, Novice Dressage & Intermediate Dressage (Julia Izzard). Sadly, neither Debbie or Liz could attend the Dressage to Music Championships due to horse issues, Julia will be heading off to represent the club in the Novice and Intermediate Dressage Championships later this year.

We introduced the helpers charter at the beginning of 2019 and it has proved easy to run and a great help towards team & helpers expenses. We will, as you will have seen in the last Newsletter, be continuing with the scheme but with a few tweaks due to our slightly dwindling resources. BRC Grassroots Points League 2020

The Grassroots Points League is a new opportunity for all BRC Members

All dressage (Walk and Trot and Prelim Level) and show jumping (60cms and 70cms) competitors can gain points at BRC Club organised competitions. Area Qualifiers and National level competitions will not count. Points can be gained when competing at BRC Club organised competitions only.

There will be two separate leagues; show jumping and dressage. Monthly score updates will be provided; therefore competitors must return their score card to the BRC head office no later than the 7th of the following month. Results on cards received after this time will not count. The competition will run for ten months from **January – October 2020**, there will be rosettes down to 10th place, sashes down to 3rd and there will be an overall supreme champion prize for the competitor who has accumulated the most points in the two leagues.

It's so simple, just follow these easy steps:

1. Download and print your blank points card from the BRC website.
2. Compete at any dressage (Walk & Trot and Prelim Level) or show jumping (60cms & 70cms) BRC Club organised competition.
3. Ask the Secretary at the event to confirm your placing with their signature.
4. Post your completed points card back to BRC HQ by the 7th of the following month.
5. Finally, wait for the results.
