Body protectors and any hats not carrying the 2018 Aqua coloured tag must be presented to the Secretary when collecting number.

The Cross Country Course may be walked on Saturday 13th October between 2-6 pm & Show Jumping may be walked on the day of competition

Grid reference TQ7413349151. Bonfleur is situated on Bon Fleur Lane, just off Redwall Lane which is just off the A229 at the bottom of Linton Hill, between Maidstone and Staplehurst.

Horse-box Sign:

Please clearly display on an A4 sign inside the windscreen of your vehicle your own name and contact number (plus emergency contact number for the day). This will facilitate us contacting you in an emergency.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY & RULES:

These horse trials will be run under BRC Official Rules 2018 which can be found online at www.britishridingclubs.org.uk.

HORSE TRIALS COMPETITORS:

A XC number bib will not be issued to each competitor and therefore competitors do need to bring their own.

NUMBERS FOR DRESSAGE & SHOW JUMPING:

Card numbers will be issued (separate numbers if doing more than one discipline) – these must be used as it is difficult for stewards to see bridle numbers in a large open area.

Hat Tagging: PAS015 & VG1 01.040 2014-12 with BSI kitemark or Inspec IC Mark; ASTM F1163: 2004a onwards with SEI mark; Snell 2001 or 2016. See BRC Rules for full range. All hats must be tagged before competitors may ride. Hats may be tagged at the competition in the Secretary's. See BRC Rules Appendix 4. All hats must be tagged with an **AQUA Coloured Tag – BRC, BE or PC**.

Body Protectors: BETA Level 3 (2009 or later) must be worn in the cross-country phase and are recommended for Show Jumping. The ONLY exception to the requirement for a BETA Level 3 2009 purple label is that Exo Body Cages will continue to be accepted, provided they have a BETA Level 3 2000 purple label.

- Paper Number Inserts will be provided. Competitors must provide their own number bibs.
- Any horse or pony, which is considered by a Judge or the Organisers to be unsound, unfit or unhealthy, will be excluded from further competition without any refund of entry fee.
- All competitors must be accompanied by another person.
- All dogs must be kept on leads.

Objections: Objections must be made in writing to the Secretary within half an hour of the incident together with a £50 deposit. The deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.

Health and Safety Statement: The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of every person present.
