Including qualifiers for The Sunshine Tour Championships, SEEL Arena Eventing Championship  
(Championships held 5 - 6th October 2024 Washbrook Farm, Aston-le-Walls)

<b>Class 1</b>	<b>70cm (including Sunshine Tour qualifier)</b>
Open to Teams of 3/4 and Individuals Section J: Juniors, Section S: Seniors. <u>Horse Eligibility:</u> 0 (10 BE Foundation Points), Horses may be registered with BE but must not have any BE points. Not to have completed a BE 90 or above in the current or previous calendar year. <u>Rider Eligibility:</u> Not to have completed a BE90, AE90, BRC HT90 or CH90 or above in the current competition year. Rider not to compete at 90 or above in qualifier or championship.	
<b>Class 2</b>	<b>80cm (including Sunshine Tour and SEEL AE qualifiers)</b>
Open to Teams of 3/4 and Individuals Section J: Juniors, Section S: Seniors. <u>Horse Eligibility:</u> 0 BE Points, Horses may be registered with BE but must not have any BE points. Not to have completed a BE 100 or above in the current or previous calendar year. <u>Rider Eligibility:</u> see note below.	
<b>Class 3</b>	<b>90cm Mixed Class (including Sunshine Tour and SEEL AE qualifiers)</b>
Open to Teams of 3/4, made up of Senior and/or Juniors, and Individuals. <u>Horse Eligibility:</u> 5 BE Points, All horses may be currently registered with BE but must not have completed a BE105 or higher in the current or previous calendar year. <u>Rider Eligibility:</u> see note below.	
<b>Class 4</b>	<b>100cm Mixed Class (including Sunshine Tour qualifier)</b>
Open to Teams of 3/4, made up of Senior and/or Juniors, and Individuals <u>Eligibility:</u> Unlimited BE Points no rider restrictions. <u>Riders Eligibility Note:</u> Riders who have completed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years. For Eventing restrictions at AE70, AE80, AE90, CT75, CT85, HT70, HT80, HT90, CC70, CC80 and CC90 applies to 3* and above only. For AE100, HT 100 and CC100 applies to 4* and above only.	

**ENTRY FEE: £45.00**

**All entries will compete in the main Competition section with Rosettes and Prizes from Lodge Farm**

COMPETITORS: You must be authorised by your Club Team Organiser who will make your CLUB PRE-ENTRY.

ENTRIES CLOSE: midday Saturday 1st June 2024.

## BRC INFORMATION

- Eligibility for all classes can be found in the current BRC Handbook.
- All competitors must be a BRC member & be on the BRC Database by midday Friday 7<sup>th</sup> June.
- This competition will run under BRC Rules, anyone in attendance will be bound by the BRC Code of Conduct. Please see the current BRC Handbook, the BRC Rule Amendments & Changes
- Horses may compete twice at two consecutive heights. Horses may compete in teams at each height or as an individual.
- Where a senior and junior are sharing a horse, the horse may only still compete twice total in a competition and must be at the same or consecutive heights. For example a senior could compete in the Senior 80 as part of a team or individually, and the junior could compete in the Junior 80 as part of a team or individually. For mixed classes juniors and seniors are not permitted to share a horse in the same class
- No horse may compete twice in the same team or in more than one team in the same class
- A horse may be shared by two seniors or two juniors but one must compete as an individual and may not ride the same test or height

## ENTRIES INFORMATION

### **STEP 1: Pre-entries:**

**TEAM ORGANISERS must submit a pre-entry to BRC by 19<sup>th</sup> May (Ind: £14.50; Team: £56).**

**Late entries cannot be guaranteed and so therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been gained.**

Late pre-entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £5 per individual and £10 per team (payable on the BRC pre entries website) if space permits.

If a pre-entry is made, clubs are agreeing to a binding constitution which means they must make an area entry payable to the designated account, regardless of whether or not the team/individual competes.

### **STEP 2: Area Entries**

Late entries are subject to the organiser's discretion at a charge of £5 per horse.

## EVENT INFORMATION: See also the Lodge Farm Schedule

- **Hats, Body Protectors and Flu Vaccination Record to be presented at the BRC Secretary before competing.**
- **Hats:** All hats must have a visible pink BRC/BE/PC hat tag in place before they are worn on the showground. **Tagging at the BRC Secretary.** Hats must NOT have a fixed peak for cross country.
- **Body Protectors:** A body protector is obligatory.
- **Times:** Times will be given for all classes. These will be posted online after 3pm on Thursday 6 June on the Lodge Farm website.
- **Numbers:** Printed numbers will be issued. Please make sure you have your own competition bib with you. Bibs must be worn on top of clothing/body protectors with number showing.
- **Withdrawals:** Those who withdraw by email to Lodge Farm before the closing date will have their entry fee, less an admin fee of £5 per class, refunded. Entry fees in any other circumstances will not be refunded. There will be no refund of BRC Prelim entries
- **Flu Vaccinations:** For any horse not on the Area 10 Database, please send a copy by 24<sup>th</sup> May to [jo.cocker@gmail.com](mailto:jo.cocker@gmail.com).
- **Please abide by any signage.** Spectators are welcome but please park as directed and not in the lorry park. Please keep children under close supervision.
- **All dogs must be kept on SHORT leads (non-extending) at all times.**
- The ruling of the Judges, Fence Judges, Timekeepers and Stewards is final. A deposit of £15.00 must be lodged prior to an objection (in writing), which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
- The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to any class for whatever reason they deem necessary, to disqualify any rider at any stage, to alter the schedule at any time. Should the event be abandoned then a £4.00 admin fee will be retained on all refunds.
- No liability shall fall on the Organisers, Landowners, Judges and Officials in respect of any loss, damage or injury howsoever caused and all competitors are deemed to be liable to indemnify the said persons in respect of any such loss, damage or injury.
