Dressage Qualifier

- Class 1:** **Senior Intro Dressage:** Individual only, BD Intro C (2016)
- Class 2:** **Senior Preliminary Dressage:** for teams of 3/4 riders, with 3 scores to count, and for individuals (all team members are automatically in the individual competition). All riders will ride a different test. BD Prelim 7 (2002), Prelim 13 (2006), Prelim 14 (2006), Prelim 18 (2002)
- Class 3:** **Senior Open Dressage:** for teams of 3/4 riders, with 3 scores to count, and for individuals. All riders will ride a different test. BD Novice 24 (2010), BD Novice 30 (2006), BD Novice 23 (2012), BD Elementary 43 (2006)
- Class 4:** **Pick a Test:** open to Junior and Senior Individuals, BD Medium 61 (2002) or Advanced Medium 92 (2011)
- Class 5:** **Senior Riding Test:** for teams of 3/4 riders, with 3 scores to count, and for individuals. Two riders will ride the Prelim test and two will ride the Novice test. BD Prelim 12 (2005), BD Novice 27 (2007) using BRC Riding Test score sheet (2014)
- Class 6:** **Junior Intro Dressage:** Individual only, BD Intro C (2016)
- Class 7:** **Junior Dressage:** for teams of 3/4 riders, with 3 scores to count, and for individuals. All riders will ride a different test. BD Prelim 7 (2002), BD Prelim 13 (2006), BD Prelim 18 (2002), BD Novice 24 (2010)
- Class 8:** **Junior Elementary:** Individual only, BD Elementary 43 (2006)
- Class 9:** **Junior Riding Test:** for teams of 3/4 riders, with 3 scores to count, and for individuals. All riders will ride the same test. BD Prelim 12 (2005) using BRC Riding Test score sheet (2014)
- Class 10:** **Mixed Junior and Senior pairs:** BRC Pairs 5 (2014)

PLEASE CHECK RIDER ELIGIBILITY AS PER RULE BOOK.

Entry fees: £72 per dressage team, £18 per individual, Pairs £30

Closing date for entries: Wednesday 15th May, 2024.

Late entries will not be accepted and no entries will be accepted over the telephone. All entries must be on BRC official entry form. Individual entries will be accepted. A preliminary entry must have been received by the Riding Clubs Office by Sunday 5th May 2024 to be eligible to enter for the qualifier.

Withdrawals /Team changes: Should be made by email before Wednesday 15th May 2024 and thereafter on the day.

Start times will be published on the SMP EVENTS website www.SMP-EVENTS.co.uk and the Area 10 website www.brcarea10.org.uk on Thursday 23rd May, 2024.

Equine influenza certificate: All competitors must have an up to date Equine Influenza Certificate which must be, upon penalty of elimination, accompany the horse to this competition and the competitor is responsible for producing it on demand. For all those horses not on the Area database, a photocopy must be sent to jo.cocker@gmail.com . **All vaccination certificates must be checked at the Secretary's before collecting your number. In order to compete a horse must be vaccinated in accordance with the rules (but not in any of the 6 preceding days) of the competition. Microchip numbers also have to be shown.**

Hat Tagging:

All hats must be tagged before competitors may ride. Hats may be tagged at the competition in the Secretary's Area. See BRC Rules Appendix 4. All hats must be tagged with a PINK Coloured Tag – BRC, BE or PC.
