**Late entries**: Will not be accepted and no entries will be accepted over the telephone. All entries must be on the BRC Official entry form and emailed to <u>Favershamridingclub@gmail.com</u>. Individual entries will be accepted. All entries must include the 'Competitors Pass' pre-entry certificate number for each member.

**Withdrawals/Team Changes**: should be made via email before Monday13th October to <a href="mailto:favershamridingclub@gmail.com">favershamridingclub@gmail.com</a> with subject heading: BRC Qualifier and date of competition, and thereafter on the day.

**Helpers:** All clubs will be required to send helpers and must be submitted on the BRC Helpers Form along with your entry forms.

Each club must provide one helper per team entered, as well as one helper per two individuals entered, for the day of the competition. More than one person may be used to cover a helper's slot. This is down to the club to arrange, NOT the organiser. E.g. Each helper is required for an allotted time during the day, so a club may provide up to 2 people to cover this period. However this is still counted as 1 helper. If Club volunteers do not fulfil their duties, that Club's riders may be at risk of eliminations and not be allowed to continue in the competition.

**Times:** Will be published via the https://www.ridingclubresults.co.uk/ platform, no later than the evening of 15<sup>th</sup> October 2025 and on Area 10 and Faversham & District Riding Club Facebook pages and www.favershamridingclub.co.uk

This competition will be run under BRC Rules, anyone in attendance will be bound by the BRC Code of Conduct. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Handbook and also BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document which can be found at the link below:

**Equine Influenza Certificate:** All competitors must have an up-to-date Equine Influenza Certificate which must, upon penalty of elimination, accompany the horse to this competition and the competitor is responsible for producing it on demand. **For all those horses not on the Area Database**, **a photocopy must be sent to megillam3@gmail.com** 

All vaccinations certificates must be checked at the Secretary's before competing. In order to compete, a horse must be vaccinated in accordance with the rules (but not in any of the 6 preceding days) of the competition. Microchip numbers also have to be shown.

**Hat Tagging:** All hats must be clearly tagged with the current colour before competitors can ride. Hats may be tagged at the competition in the Secretary's Area. See BRC Rules Appendix 4

**Horse Box Sign:** Please clearly display on the inside of your vehicle, your name, your club and a contact number (plus emergency contact number for the day). This will facilitate us contacting you in an emergency.
