CLASS 1	MINI MINIMUS JUMPING	Jumps 30cm (may be assisted)
CLASS 2	MINIMUS JUMPING	Jumps 45cm
CLASS 3	SCURRY (one round against clock)	Jumps 60cm

CLASSES 4 – 7 WILL BE 2 STAGE

CLASS 4	NOVICE JUMPING Combination not to have been placed 1 st in Show Jumping	Jumps 60 cm
CLASS 5	INTERMEDIATE JUMPING	Jumps 75cm
CLASS 6	SMALL OPEN JUMPING	Jumps 80cm
CLASS 7	OPEN JUMPING	Jumps 85cm

Neither horse or rider must never have been placed 1st in showing class

Riders may be assisted/led. Snaffle bridles only (lead reins to be attached to the nosebands).

CLASS 13 LEADING REIN – Riders 10 & under Ponies 12.2 & under

CLASS 14 FIRST RIDDEN – Riders 12 & under Ponies 13.2 & under

CLASS 15 BEST RIDER – Rosette to best Junior Rider

CLASS 16 IN HAND - VETERAN (Horse / Pony 15 yrs or over)

CLASS 17 IN HAND – HANDSOMEST GELDING

CLASS 18 IN HAND – PRETTIEST MARE

- CLASS 19** **IN HAND - NATIVE PONY**
- CLASS 20** **RIDING CLUB HORSE / PONY CLUB PONY**
Judged on Horse suitability for participating in all riding club activities.
Will be required to jump 2 – 3 jumps 65-70cm
- CLASS 21** **RIDDEN COB**
- CLASS 22** **RIDDEN VETERAN** (Horse / Pony 15yrs & over)
- CLASS 23** **RIDDEN NATIVE PONY**

INDOOR ARENA DRESSAGE (warm up in outdoor arena)

Classes 24 & 25 are HAVE-A-GO DRESS DOWN DRESSAGE CLASSES

Dress code for classes 24 & 25 is smart casual. All riders MUST wear a hat conforming to BRC Standards for 2018 and boots with a heel but may wear their own choice in between. As the name suggests these are fun supportive dressage classes to encourage those of you who want to have-a-go at dressage but don't want to dress up to do it., there is no need for show jackets and you don't need to plait! All we ask is you come, have a go and have fun! You may also enter these classes in traditional dressage attire if you wish.

1. The Judges and stewards decision is final.
2. Every care will be taken, but no responsibility can be taken for injury, loss or damage to any person(s), their property or animals howsoever caused. All cars, trailers, boxes are parked at owner's own risk.
3. The Organisers reserve the right to:
Refuse any entrant without stating a reason for so doing.
Alter the schedule, class(es) and prizes, as they feel necessary.
4. Any objections must be made in writing to the show secretary within 15 minutes of the incident occurring with a deposit of £20.00 that will only be returned if the objection is substantiated.
5. **All competitors must be correctly attired. Hard hats conforming to 2019 BRC Hat Guidelines must be worn at ALL times when mounted with chinstraps correctly fastened. All competitors in jumping classes are strongly advised to wear approved body protectors. 6. All riders / owners of animals on the show ground are responsible for their own safety and that of others. All persons to remain within the defined showground.
7. Any person(s) seen using whips or spurs with undue severity or mistreating any animal in any way will be asked to leave the showground and may be banned from all future FDRC events.
8. Practice fences and exercising areas are allotted, **DO NOT** canter, gallop or warm up outside of these areas or within the defined parking areas.
9. **Dressage entries to be received by post by Wednesday 8th May.** No responsibility can be taken for entries delayed or lost in the post.
10. **Declarations:** All dressage entrants to report to the steward 10 minutes before their allotted time(s)
11. All Horses / Ponies entered in any ridden class(es) must be 4years of age or over.
12. **All Dogs must be on leads & under control at all times.**
13. **DRESSAGE** - To be judged under BD rules.
14. **SHOW JUMPING** - To be judged structured on BS rules.
15. Entry fees will only be returned at the discretion of the organisers and on production of a valid Veterinary / Doctors certificate.
