Eligibility for all Qualifier classes (Q) can be found in the current BRC Handbook 2025. Eligibility will be taken from the close of pre-entry. All competitors must be registered members on the BRC membership platform (Sport:80) the last working day before the competition date. This is a Mixed Combined Training Competition for Teams of 3 or 4 Riders and Individuals. Teams can be mixed. Junior and Senior Members compete on equal terms. All Team members are automatically in the individual competition.

Closing date for detailed entries to F&DRC 2nd May 2025

- Class N1 (Q) - BD Prelim 1 (2024) - 60cm
- Class N2 (Q) - BD Prelim 2 (2024) - 60cm
- Class N3 (Q) - BD Prelim 2 (2024) - 70cm
- Class N4 (Q) - BD Novice 2 (2024) - 70cm
- Class N5 (Q) - Novice CT Team – Each Team Member rides in a different Class N1 to N4

Open Combined Training Team/Individuals

- Class O6 (Q) - BD Prelim 1 (2024) - 80cm
- Class O7 (Q) - BD Novice 1 (2024) – 80cm
- Class O8 (Q) - BD Prelim 2 (2024) - 90cm
- Class O9 (Q) - BD Novice 2 (2024) - 90cm
- Class O10 (Q) - Open CT Team – Each Team Member rides in a different Class O6 to O9

Unaffiliated Combined Training Individuals

- Class U11 - BD Prelim 1 (2024) - 60cm
- Class U12 - BD Prelim 2 (2024) – 70cm
- Class U13 - BD Novice 1 (2024) - 80cm
- Class U14 - BD Novice 2 (2024) - 90cm

Entry Fee - £120 per Team and £30 per Individual Qualifier Classes
£30 per individual for Unaffiliated classes (No Prelim Entry to Pay)

All Qualifier Classes require a Preliminary Entry to be made to BRC which close on 19th April 2025 and represents a commitment to enter the competition. Preliminary Entries made on line - Fee £56 per Team & £14.50 per Individual. Late pre-entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £5 per individual and £10 per team (payable to BRC HQ) if space permits. Late entries cannot be guaranteed and therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been gained.

Hats

All hats must have a visible **PINK** BRC/BE/PC hat tag in place before they are worn on the showground, to show that they meet the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to tag hats for you if your hat does not currently have one. For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook.

Horse-Box Sign

Please clearly display a on an A4 sign inside the windscreen of your vehicle, your Club, Your Own Name and Contact number (plus emergency contact number for the day), This will facilitate us contacting you in an emergency.

Flu Vaccinations & Microchips

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations following rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. **A copy of each horse's passport must be sent in with your detailed entry and the horse's passport must be presented on the day of the competition to check the last vaccination entry date.** It is compulsory for all horses to be microchipped.

General Rules

- 1 The competition will be run strictly under British Riding Club Rules 2025.
- 2 In the event of cancellation of this event £5 shall be retained per competitor.
- 3 All entries are accepted only upon the terms of the general rules and conditions within this schedule.
- 4 The Judge's decision is final.
- 5 ALL HORSES/PONIES ENTERED FOR BRC QUALIFIERS MUST HAVE A VACCINATION RECORD COMPLYING WITH BRC RULE G7, THIS RECORD AND PASSPORT MUST BE BROUGHT ON THE DAY OF THE COMPETITION. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CLUBS TO ENSURE THESE ARE CORRECT.
- 6 Health and Safety – The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health & safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards,
- 7 Disclaimer of Liability – Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the British Horse Society, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles, land or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way what so ever.
- 8 Protective Headgear – Protective Headgear must be worn at all times.
All hats must be tagged with a **PINK Coloured Tag – BRC, BE or PC.**
- 9 All dogs must be kept on leads at all times while on the show ground.
- 10 Entries will not be accepted without the correct entry fees
- 11 Only riders and/or horses competing may use the warm up facilities at FSC.
- 12 **Please do not to leave litter or muck out horse boxes in the box park.**
- 13 Horses must not be tied to horseboxes or trailers & left unattended.
- 14 All ridden horses/ponies must be 4yrs or over.
- 15 Protests – These may be lodged only by the Chairman or Chef d'Equipe or nominated representative of the club concerned. These must be in writing and accompanied by a deposit of £20.00. They must be addressed to the organiser of the competition.
- 16 All persons attending the show will be deemed to have accepted the rules and conditions.

ANY HORSE/PONY ATTENDING THE COMPETITION WITHOUT A PASSPORT AND VACCINATION RECORD MAY BE DISQUALIFIED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE OFFICIAL STEWARD

There will be no guaranteed Prize Giving on the day. BRC Rosettes to be awarded: 1st to 6th

The highest placed individuals not part of the winning qualifying team from each arena will also qualify to compete at the National Championships subject to eligibility.

Results will be posted online as soon as we can. Sheets and Rosettes will be posted, if not collected.
