BRC Club Jumping Series

The aim of this series is to create an accessible and inclusive Show Jumping series for BRC members who currently do not take part in qualifiers, perhaps due to be nervous about competing, have disabilities which prevents them from jumping higher or those who are new to BRC and maybe have never jumped before.

The Competition

To qualify for the finals, competitors must complete two clear rounds at the relevant height to gain qualification.

Riders may attend any club/area competition within the pilot scheme areas.

At the finals the competition will be run under BRC SJ rules using a single-phase format, if a rider is clear, they will proceed straight onto a jump-off course.

Any club/area SJ competition can be used to gain clear rounds provided the class produces a result within the class (i.e. competitors are placed).

Assisted

One assistant per rider is permitted. Where an assistant enters the arena to help a competitor, they may move around the ring and be alongside the horse but must not jump the fences. Coaching & encouragement around the course is permitted. No lead rein allowed.

Dress and Tack

Hats to current BRC standard – please see the handbook.

Correct riding clothes must be worn when mounted but competition dress is not required.

Spurs are not permitted, and whips must be padded if carried.

How to Enter

Qualification cards are available for purchase <https://brc.bhs.org.uk/select> Members will need to create an account, then go to the event entry section and select Club SJ Series Qualification Form. The Horse and Rider must be stated on the purchase to be valid.

Qualification forms may be purchased retrospectively within 21 days of the competition (but not after the qualification period has ended), providing the result can be proven. Riders must be a member of a club within the pilot scheme areas before competing.

The Qualification Form/Online Link will be emailed out to the person purchasing.

Qualification cards must be purchased per combination and are £11.00 each. Printing and posting is available for those who wish to receive a hard copy at additional cost. The qualification card fee is non refundable.

The purpose of this series is to provide riders with the opportunity to experience the excitement of competition. The rules are, therefore, kept as flexible as possible but, please embrace the “spirit” of the rules. Please do not use this series to trophy hunt if you are capable of jumping higher, as it is not in the spirit of the competition.

Eligibility-

Riders must be a member of an affiliated club at the time of competing.

Eligibility for the finals is as follows:

50cm - Rider may not have competed in any competition with a jumping element at 70 or higher in the previous 12 months.

60cm - Rider may not have competed in any competition with a jumping element at 75cm or higher in the previous 12 months.

Combinations must not have completed a jumping phase at a BRC Championship (to include HT, AE, CC, CT and SJ).

60cm

Combinations must not have completed a jumping phase at a BRC Championship at 70 or above (to include HT, AE, CC, CT and SJ). Combinations may not have been placed 1st – 3rd in a BRC Championship at 60cm.

Open section: At final has no eligibility restrictions on either horse or rider but should not be entered by those capable of competing at higher heights.

Onus is on the rider to ensure compliance with the eligibility criteria to maintain the spirit of the competition.

At finals riders may only compete at two consecutive heights.

Classes

Class SJ50 - Round of show jumps max height 50cm

Class SJ60 - Round of show jumps max height 60cm

Drawn Order

These classes are a single-phase format, if a rider is clear, they will proceed straight onto a jump-off course.

Entry Fee - £15 per Qualifier Class

Rosettes to be awarded: 1st to 6th

Hats

All hats must have a visible **PINK** BRC/BE/PC hat tag in place before they are worn on the showground, to show that they meet the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to tag hats for you if your hat does not currently have one. For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook.

Horse-Box Sign

Please clearly display a on an A4 sign inside the windscreen of your vehicle, your Club, Your Own Name and Contact number (plus emergency contact number for the day), This will facilitate us contacting you in an emergency.

Flu Vaccinations & Microchips

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations following rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. **A copy of each horse's passport must be sent in with your detailed entry and the horse's passport must be presented on the day of the competition to check the last vaccination entry date.** It is compulsory for all horses to be microchipped.

Eligibility and Rules: Refer to current BRC Rulebook 2025 for full details and rules.

General Rules

- 1 The competition will be run strictly under British Riding Club Rules 2025.
- 2 In the event of cancellation of this event £5 shall be retained per competitor.
- 3 All entries are accepted only upon the terms of the general rules and conditions within this schedule.
- 4 The Judge's decision is final.
- 5 ALL HORSES/PONIES ENTERED FOR BRC QUALIFIERS MUST HAVE A VACCINATION RECORD COMPLYING WITH BRC RULE G7, THIS RECORD AND PASSPORT MUST BE BROUGHT ON THE DAY OF THE COMPETITION. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CLUBS TO ENSURE THESE ARE CORRECT.
- 6 Health and Safety – The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health & safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards,
- 7 Disclaimer of Liability – Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the British Horse Society, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles, land or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way what so ever.
- 8 Protective Headgear – Protective Headgear must be worn at all times.
All hats must be tagged with a **PINK Coloured Tag – BRC, BE or PC.**
- 9 All dogs must be kept on leads at all times while on the show ground.
- 10 Entries will not be accepted without the correct entry fees
- 11 Only riders and/or horses competing may use the warm up facilities at FSC.
- 12 **Please do not to leave litter or muck out horse boxes in the box park.**
- 13 Horses must not be tied to horseboxes or trailers & left unattended.
- 14 All ridden horses/ponies must be 4yrs or over.
- 15 Protests – These may be lodged only by the Chairman or Chef d'Equipe or nominated representative of the club concerned. These must be in writing and accompanied by a deposit of £20.00. They must be addressed to the organiser of the competition.
- 16 All persons attending the show will be deemed to have accepted the rules and conditions.

ANY HORSE/PONY ATTENDING THE COMPETITION WITHOUT A PASSPORT AND VACCINATION RECORD MAY BE DISQUALIFIED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE OFFICIAL STEWARD
